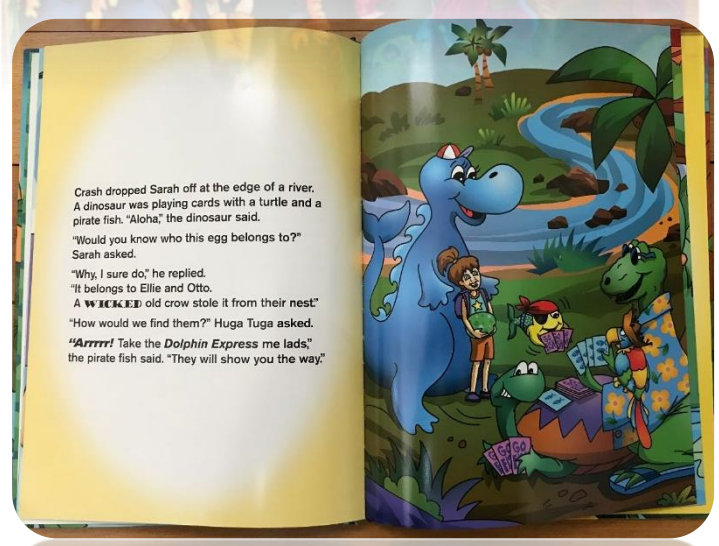
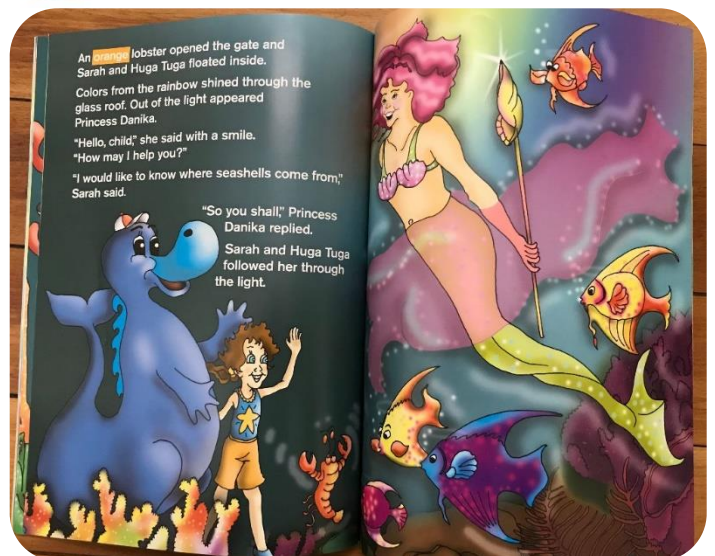

"You're welcome, Sarah," Huga Tuga said. "Now say 'GAZZLING DANCING DINOSAURS' backwards three times."

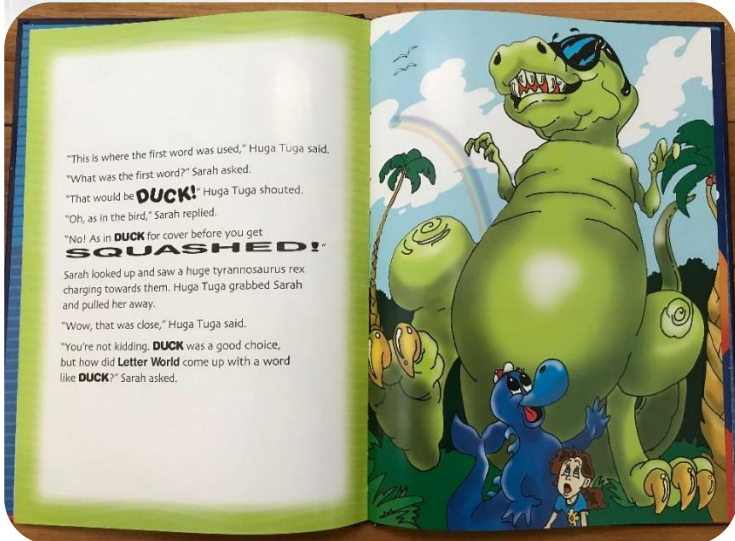

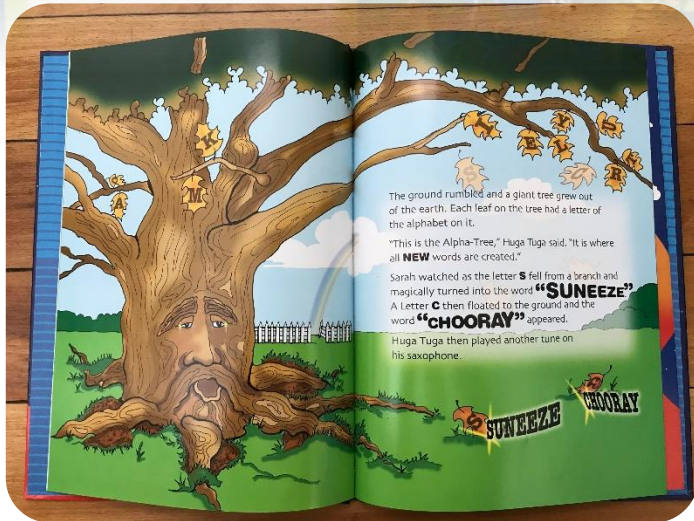

The word **CHOORAY** went sailing through the night and was buried in the ghostly graveyard of rejected words.

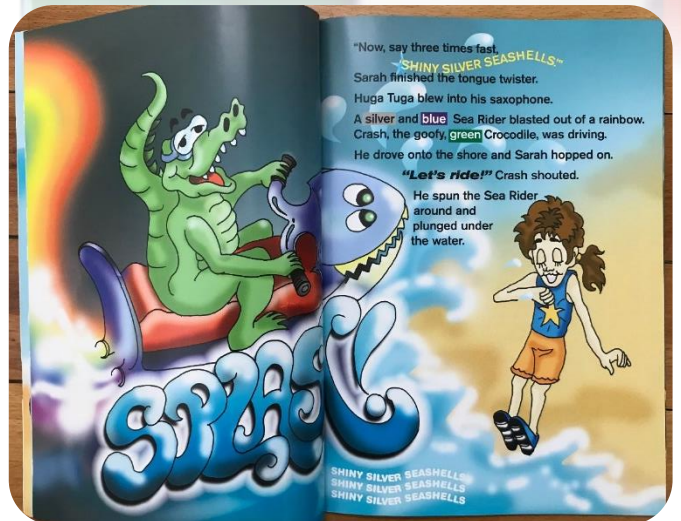


The ground rumbled and a giant tree grew out of the earth. Each leaf on the tree had a letter of the alphabet on it.
